Rich Kluin, Vice President of Finance and Operations, presented the results of the **bids submitted for the Laboratory and Ed Wood Renovation Project on the Southeast Tech Campus**. Construction on the Southeast Tech new Laboratory Building for expanded Auto and Diesel Technician programs and renovation of the Ed Wood Building to expand the capacity of the Collision Repair and Refinish Technician programs will begin following the authorization of the construction contract. The project has a fall 2016 completion.

The new Laboratory Building will provide additional instructional space that will allow Southeast Tech to double the number of student enrollments in the Auto and Diesel programs. The new Laboratory Building will also provide space for improved service offerings and includes a 500 seat auditorium,

consolidated administrative offices, and food service space. The renovation of the Ed Wood Building will allow Southeast Tech to double the enrollments of the Collision Repair/Refinish program by increasing the instructional space of the program. Funding for the construction project will be provided by the sale of Health and Education Facility Bonds. The net proceeds of the April 2015 sale were \$18,372,057. The remaining construction costs of \$2,360,943 will be funded with post-secondary funds which are a part of Southeast Tech's tentatively adopted FY16-FY20 Capital Plan. Capital Plan allocations for the construction costs include \$1,138,925 from capital reserves in FY16 and \$1,147,276 from capital reserves in FY17.

Following general discussion, a motion was made by Doug Morrison and seconded by Carly Reiter, five (5) votes "yes" on roll call, acknowledging the administration's report of the study of bids for the Laboratory and Ed Wood Renovations Project on the Southeast Tech Campus which have been received during the prior 30 days and were opened, read and tabulated in the Central Services Center – Purchasing Department and approving the bid of the lowest responsible bidder, Golden Rule Construction (see PD #3002 and FY15 Legal Publication #98) be awarded to Golden Rule Construction for their lowest responsible bid in the amount of \$20,733,000.00, (FY 16 Post-Secondary Technical Fund) and authorizing the Business Manager to issue contracts to be executed by Golden Rule Construction (see Contract 15-060; JRK and MRF # ST31); and upon execution, the contract(s) will be entered into and executed for, and on behalf of the District by the Business Manager and the President of the School Board, and thereupon, the bid security, if any, now on deposit with the Purchasing Supervisor of the District, be surrendered, all in accordance with Policy/Regulation DJ.
