### Action ST00336

Tracy Noldner, Executive Director of Student Affairs and Institutional Effectiveness presented the Strategic Plan and Mission Continuation Report. (MRF #ST262) At the School Board's August 1, 2018 meeting, Southeast Tech presented the 2018 Strategic Plan Update Report for the 2018-2021 Strategic Plan. The report highlighted Southeast Tech's progress toward the successful implementation of the Strategic Plan, including specific measures with target levels of achievement.

Wednesday, October 3, 2018

At the September 2018 meeting of the Southeast Tech Council, the Council voted to recommend to the School Board that Southeast Tech continue to operate under its current Mission, Vision and Values to guide the institute, as well as to continue to pursue the goals and objectives of the current Strategic Plan for the FY19 academic year.

Following general discussion, a motion was made by Todd Thoelke and seconded by Kate Parker, four (4) votes "yes" on roll call, **acknowledging the Strategic Plan and Mission Continuation Report.** 

## Action ST00337

Tracy Noldner, Executive Director of Student Affairs and Institutional Effectiveness presented the Higher Learning Commission Update Report. (MRF #ST263). The Higher Learning Commission has formally removed the Academic Quality Initiative Program (AQIP) as a pathway for accreditation, requiring Southeast Tech to transition to the Open Pathway. While this transition will require Southeast Tech to make some adjustments to its accreditation process and preparation for the institute's next accreditation visit, the adjustments are small, and Southeast Tech will be able to utilize what it has developed through AQIP as part of the Open Pathway requirement.
