Megan Fischer, VP for Enrollment Management, provided the Fall 2019 Enrollment Report. (see MRF #ST318) Fall 2019 enrollment highlights are as follows:

- Southeast Tech's Fall 2019 headcount is up eight percent (8%) from 2,268 students in Fall 2018 to 2,456 students this fall
- Southeast Tech's degree-seeking students is also up 2.5 percent
- In rank of our highest enrollment for fall semesters, Fall 2019 is our 5th highest fall semester at Southeast Tech
