Dr. Benjamin Valdez, Vice President of Academics, presented the Dual and Concurrent Enrollment Update Report. (MRF #ST406) Southeast Technical College has been working with the Sioux Falls School District 49-5 on establishing a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on Current Enrollment. The MOU established the process for high school faculty to become certified to teach Southeast Technical Collee courses at the high school. Students enrolled in the concurrent enrollment courses will be earning high school credit and college credit at Southeast Tech.

Southeast Tech has established partnerships with the Harrisburg, Tea and Brandon Valley School Districts. We are providing students with the opportunity to enroll in and take courses in construction management, health care, and welding.
