#### **Purpose:**

To provide the School Board an overview of Academic Program Accreditation and which academic programs have obtained accreditation.

Program accreditation represents a significant commitment of time and resources by faculty and staff to obtain academic program accreditation. Southeast Tech has a number of programs that have obtained accreditation and these programs are concentrated in three institutes: Institute of Health Services, Institute of Industrial Technology and Institute of Transportation Technology. Academic program accreditation provides a number of benefits for our programs, students and graduates including: industry recognition, access to resources, training & curriculum and advancement for graduates.

### **Higher Education Accreditation**

A type of quality assurance process under which services and operations of post-secondary educational institutions or programs are evaluated by an external body to determine if applicable standards are met. If standards are met, accredited status is granted by the agency.

#### Program Accreditation involves two major steps:

- ► An extensive self-evaluation
  - Led by faculty with input from Lab Specialists, Administration, Industry and Advisory Committee members
  - 2. Programs submit program application and self-evaluation materials
  - 3. Rate their program based upon a set of identified standards

#### On site evaluation:

Led by an evaluation team comprised of industry representatives from other programs

- Activities include:
- 1. Interviews with faculty, staff, administration, students, graduates, industry representatives and advisory committee members
- 2. Facility review including classrooms, labs and equipment
- 3. Curriculum review
- 4. School, program and personnel record reviews
- 5. Determine compliance with identified standards
  - a) Identify areas of strength
  - b) Identify areas of non-compliance
- If a program has areas of non-compliance, a corrective action plan must be developed and submitted

### Why Would a Program Seek Accreditation?

- In some cases, we would not be able to offer the program if we were not accredited
  - In some health programs, graduates can not sit for their National Boards if they do not graduate from an accredited program.
- Industry recognition
- Access to resources, training, curriculum
- Advancement for graduates

### Why Don't All Programs Seek Accreditation?

- > Some program areas do not have an accrediting body
  - Engineering
  - Networking
- ► Some accrediting bodies are geared for Bachelor Degree Programs only
  - Business

Southeast Tech has 16 programs which have obtained accreditation. These programs are concentrated in three Institutes:

- ▶ 2. Institute of Industrial Technology
- ▶ 3. Institute of Transportation Technology

Since the program has received National Accreditation (ACEN) the South Dakota Board of Nursing does not conduct site visits.

#### LPN:

- 2014 pass rate for graduates that took the NCLEX-PN Board Exam the first time 99%
- 2015 pass rate to date: 99%

#### Phlebotomy:

- National Board pass rate: 86%
- Southeast Tech pass rate: 93%
