Southeast Tech 2016 Enrollment Report EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Purpose:

To provide the School Board an update on the final enrollment figures for the Fall 2016 semester.

Overall enrolments for Fall 2016 fell slightly below the Fall 2015 enrollment count with 34 less students and 541 less credits. Of the 2,162 students enrolled for the Fall 2016 semester, 807 were brand new students to Southeast Tech, a slight increase over the 792 brand new students the institute saw in Fall 2015.

While the increase in brand new students is encouraging after a fall of nearly 100 brand new students from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015, enrolling new students will continue to be a challenge. Regional unemployment rates are at record lows, which is expected to continue and will be a challenge in recruiting students in the future; however, Southeast Tech is developing certificate options for employed individuals that can help them get a start on their education while continuing their employment.

The decreasing number of high school graduates in the region, as well as the increased competition for these graduates is also a challenge; however, Southeast Tech is working on ways to streamline its entrance requirement processes, increase communications with prospective students, develop stronger relationships with area high schools, and increase the opportunities to get these students to visit our campus.

Southeast Tech has set as its goal to increase brand new students to 850 for Fall 2017, an increase of 5.3% from Fall 2016.
