- Students become certified for 2 years.

PHARMACY TECHNICIAN PROGRAM

- Three semesters
 - Fall 19 credits first semester
 - Spring 20 credits second semester
 - Summer 9 credits
- Total = 48 credits
- 8 weeks of clinical training (during summer semester)
 - 4 weeks in a hospital
 - 4 weeks in a retail
- 1 start
 - August

PHARMACY TECHNICIAN PROGRAM

- The Pharmacy Technician Program is accredited by
 - ASHP (American Society of Health-System Pharmacists) and
 - ACPE (Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education
- In July the students sit for a National Pharmacy Certification Exam given by PTCB (Pharmacy Technician Certification Board)
- Every two years must get 20 continuing education credits
