EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Purpose:

To inform the School Board of Southeast Tech's Higher Learning Commission (HLC) pathway transition from the Academic Quality Initiative Program (AQIP) Pathway to the Open Pathway.

The Higher Learning Commission has formally removed the Academic Quality Initiative Program (AQIP) as a pathway for accreditation, requiring Southeast Tech to transition to the Open Pathway. While this transition will require Southeast Tech to make some adjustments to its accreditation process and preparation for the institute's next accreditation visit, the adjustments are small, and Southeast Tech will be able to utilize what it has developed through AQIP as part of the Open Pathway requirements.
