CONSTRUCTION PRE-APPRENTICESHIP

- Summer 2018 offering
- I0 students / I0 contractors
- Split time between classroom & worksite
- Planning to expand for Summer 2019



CARPENTRY APPRENTICESHIP

- Partnership with Home Builders of the Sioux Empire (HBASE)
- Two-year Registered Apprenticeship
- 10 students in 2 cohorts (1st & 2nd year)

PLUMBING APPRENTICSHIP

- Partnership with Hander Plumbing and Krier & Blain, Inc.
- Four-year apprenticeship
- 23 students in four cohorts (years 1 through 4)





DENTAL ASSISTING APPRENTICESHIP

- II students from nine area dental offices
- One-year apprenticeship
- Providing expanded function training and certification
- Students sit for the DANB certification exam upon completion

NEW PROGRAM PROPOSAL

- Southeast Tech proposing an academic Dental Assisting program in March of 2019
- Program to start in the Fall 2019 semester
- II-month Diploma program
- Capacity of 24 students
- Proposed at the request of area dentists and the SD Dental Assoc
