FALL 2020

- 48% of the students enrolled for Fall 2020 are part-time. (52% of students are full-time)
- 31% of the credits for Fall 2020 are taken by part-time students. (69% of credits are taken by full-time students)

- 44% of the students enrolled for Fall 2019 are part-time.
- 26% of the credits for Fall 2019 are taken by part-time students.


