


Presentation for the Sioux Falls School Board 2020-21 Year-End Report Monday, July 12,2021

## **Priorities: Grow Enrollment**

- Fall 20 up 1% in degree seeking students, but Spring 21 saw a slight decline
  - Two-year colleges remain the most affected sector of higher education by COVID-19, down 10.15% from a year ago.
- 49% of the students enrolled are part-time
  - 31% of the credits for Fall 2020 were completed by part-time students.
- Growing minority student population (17%)
  - Increase from 10% → 12% → 16% → 17% of students last fall
- Over 40% of students PELL grant eligible
- 14% of students from out-of-state



# **Increase Student Retention & Industry Support**


- Fall-to-Fall retention rate increased to 76% in 2020
  - Highest Fall-to-Fall retention rate ever at Southeast Tech
- 99% placement rate for Spring 2020 grads (88% stay in SD)
- Five consecutive years of expanding Build Dakota Scholarship Industry

Full-ride scholarships in Southeast Tech's most in-demand programs are awarded annually.










## **Nationally Ranked Programs**



# Making Southeast Tech More Accessible to All Students

- Expansion of dual credit opportunities
  - Avera Academy & Classrooms to Careers



Year 1 - Classroom to Careers (2019-2020)

- 36 Students participated
  - 23 female/13 male
- Post High School Plans
  - 39% enrolled at STC
  - 30% enrolled at other colleges
  - 30% went straight to workforce
- Students completed job shadows & had guest speakers
- Campus Visits to STC and Raven Industries
- Students Completed "Bring your A Game" and Accuplacer
- Student Feedback
  - Grateful for Free Dual Credit
  - Appreciated Career Exploration
  - Appreciated the support through the process of applying for college etc.
  - I learned how to be the best student I could be and how to improve on other things. Not only was I able to learn the information I needed, I am now able to put it into practice before I graduate high School.

Year 2- Classroom to Careers (2020-2021)

- 44 Students participated
  - 27 female/17male
  - 57% were First Generation Americans
- Post High School Plans
  - 32% enrolled at STC
  - 44% enrolled at other colleges
  - 23% went straight into Workforce
- Students engaged with over 20 guest speakers and virtual tours.
- Completed Bring your A Game and Accuplacer
- Student Feedback
  - **Exploring different Careers**
  - Never thought I was smart enough to take college courses while I was in high school
  - Bring Your A Game helped me identify my strengths and weaknesses and create my personal brand
