#### Drug Free and Alcohol-Free Work Place

#### Drug and Alcohol Testing for Commercial Drivers/Students

Southeast Technical Institute requires a drug and alcohol-free working environment.

STI will make every effort to see that STI employees requiring a commercial driver's license (CDL) and all students enrolled in the truck driving program are operating vehicles in a safe manner.

A "driver" for purposes of this policy is defined as either an employee who is required as a condition of employment to have a commercial driver's license or a truck driving student who is preparing to obtain a commercial driver's license.

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration of the U.S. Department of Transportation mandates that drivers who are required to have or who are attempting to acquire a commercial driver's license must undergo drug and alcohol testing. In response to this mandate, the STI maintains a drug and alcohol testing program for these drivers.

It is the intent of STI that all requirements of federal mandates for driver safety, as it applies to drugs and alcohol, be covered by this policy.
