Purpose:

To provide the School Board with a Fall 2020 Overview Report.

Southeast Tech President, Bob Griggs, will provide an overview of the fall semester, including information on final fall enrollment numbers, record fall-to-fall retention, placement rates for our 2020 graduates, and a summary of COVID-19 isolation and quarantine cases on campus. President Griggs will also outline some recent college program recognitions and honors, community student & staff volunteer activity, and discuss a new diversity initiative for Spring 2021.

FALL 2020 Enrollment



- **Up 1% in degree seeking students**
 - National Student Clearinghouse -9.5%
- **48% of the students enrolled for Fall 2020 are part-time**
 - 31% of the credits for Fall 2020 are taken by part-time students.
- Growing minority student population
 - (2017: 11% → 2020: 17%)
- Approx. 38% of students PELL eligible in 2019-20
- 14% of students from out-of-state
 - 2,123 in-state/303 out-of-state = 2,426 students
 - 9% dual credit enrollment



FALL 2019 to Fall 2020 Retention

- Fall-to-Fall retention rate **increased from 72% in 2019 to 76% in 2020**
 - 76% Highest Fall-to-Fall retention rate ever at Southeast Tech
 - 32% non-traditional students
- **98% placement for Spring 2020 graduates**


Southeast Tech's LPN Program Ranked #2 in Midwest







Strategies for Spring 2021:

- Signage **promoting social distancing** in campus buildings.
- **Plexiglass barriers** to reduce virus transmission.
- Continued use of hand sanitizers stations and sanitizing equipment.
(HaloMist foggers)
- **Additional cleaning protocols** and **increased ventilation** in buildings.
- **Mandatory use of face masks** in campus buildings.
- Symptom Monitoring (**temperature kiosks** across campus)
- Increased **classroom and lab social distancing** strategies.
- Some classes will **split on-campus attendance** days.
- Close working relationship with Sioux Falls Community Health.
- Following CDC recommendations for isolation and quarantine.
- Developed internal **Contact Tracing Team**.

- Graduation in a Box – Friday, Dec. 11




Growing Diverse Student Population in SF


